

AICES Rising Star Grants

The AICES Rising Star Program is designed to support young people participating at the CIS level or higher as an athlete or official.

Achievements from Term 4 of the previous year until the end of Term 3 in the current year (inclusive) can be taken into consideration.

Criteria

In order to be eligible to apply for a AICES Rising Star Program grant, students must meet the following criteria:

- Be an enrolled student at an AICES affiliated school in year 7 to 12
- Be participating in an AICES Sport as outlined on the AICES Website
- Be participating as an athlete, umpire or referee in the AICES Pathway
- AICES Team playing at the All Schools Level or higher
- An individual athlete at an All Schools Event or higher
- Be a member of multiple CIS Teams

Amount

- In AICES will award up to eight awards
- The base rate of each of the awards will be \$250
- Students attending country schools will be eligible for an additional \$50.
- Country schools are recognised as being members of the following AICES Sub Associations: HRIS, WAS and SASSA. The Illawarra Grammar School and Central Coast Sports College is also included in this group.

Applications

- All applications must be submitted on the official AICES form and must:
- Be lodged by the students school) filled out by the Sports Co-ordinator.
- Submitted as a Word Document. No scanned or posted nominations accepted.
- Be verified by the Sports Co-ordinator of the students school
- Be endorsed by the students school Principal

Selection Committee

The Committee will consist of the eight AICES Sub Association Convenors and the Executive Officer. Each will rank their top ten students which will then be compiled by the Executive Officer.

Payment

Successful applicants will be paid directly. So the award can be appropriately recognised by the school, an AICES Certificate will be posted to the students Sports Co-ordinators in mid-September.
