## **Draw and Rules**

### **Match Rules**

- We will be playing Fast 5 Rules
- Games will be best of 9 games. First to win 5 games wins. Tiebreak at 4-4
- If the serve clips the tape and lands in the service box, there's no let, it's game on. What's more, if you're playing doubles either the receiver or their partner can take the return.
- As soon as a game gets to deuce it's a Power Point. The receiver chooses which side they will take the serve. This applies to doubles as well with the receiving pair deciding who returns the point.
- At 4 games all a short tie-break is played, first to 5 points. A Power Point determines the winner at 4 points all in the Tiebreak. Receiver chooses receiving court.
- No advantage games.

### **Order of games in each Match**

- All schools must declare their player rankings to the AICES Executive Officer 1 – 4 (or 5) before the day commences.

Doubles - 1 v 1, 2 v 2 (schools can choose their own pairs but cannot change them for that match) then...

Singles - 1 v 1, 2 v 2, 3 v 3, 4 v 4

Reverse Doubles 1 v 2, 2 v 1

If 2 schools finish on equal points then the head to head result will count. If 3 or more schools finish on the same points then games for/against will be used to decide a winner.

- Schools can depart when all of their matches are finished
- Schools must nominate 4 players for each match. Those 4 must play the whole match.
- As notified on the website this no longer progresses to CIS
